

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The Russian State Agrarian Correspondence University The Vocational Secondary Education Program

For the Academic Year of 2010-2011

1. The Requirements regulate admission of the citizens of the Russian Federation as well as citizens abroad to the Russian State Agrarian Correspondence University.

2. Admission to the Russian State Agrarian Correspondence University is held according to the program to which citizens are applying. Citizens applying for the Vocational Secondary Program are assessed by taking and passing entrance exams at University and will be required to have :

*Certificate of Secondary (Full) Education or Certificate of Vocational School Education - in compliance with RSE exam results;

*Certificate of Vocational School Education and results of entrance exams held at the Russian State Agrarian Correspondence University independently for further vocational studies at the Russian State Agrarian Correspondence University on the basis of short program;

*Certificate of Secondary (Full) Education dated until January, 1/ 2009 (entering as full-time – part-time students and correspondence students only) and results of entrance exams held at the Russian State Agrarian Correspondence University independently;

*Certificate of Secondary (Full) Education from international educational establishment and results of entrance exams held at the Russian State Agrarian Correspondence University independently;

*Certificate of Vocational Secondary Education or Vocational Higher Education and results of entrance exams held at the Russian State Agrarian Correspondence University independently in order to study on the basis of short program.

In the event that applicants receive financial support from budget admission is organized on a competitive basis.

3. Period of Admission is set up by the Russian State Agrarian Correspondence University.

Entering as full-time – part-time students are applying on March,1—up to June,25.

Entering as correspondence students are applying on March,1—up to June,25 and on September,1—up to October,20.

4. Admission to the Russian State Agrarian Correspondence University is held in accordance with individual application documents.

5. The application documents should contain:

- *The Originals or original copies of identification documents;
- * The Original or original copy of State Certificate of Education;
- *The Original or original copy of RSE Certificate;
- * Six passport-size photos (3x4) of the applicant.

6. Every applicant has the right to complain to the Appellate Commission concerning any decisions and actions which he finds illegal within the period of entrance examinations.

7. International Applicants need to submit the following:

- *Application: The application for admission must be in Russian;
- *Certificates of Education: All Certificates should be the Originals legalized at determined order (if it is required) and should be accompanied by enclosures (if such enclosures are permitted by legislatures in the schools and colleges which international students have attended);
- *Attested translation of Certificates of Education and enclosures;
- *Identity Card Copy confirming international applicant identity in the Russian Federation;
- *Entry Visa Copy is available if international applicant has come to the Russian Federation on Entry Visa;
- *All the names and surnames in Russian documents must be matched to Entry Visa.
